Materials Included:

Quantity	Item
1	Touch-up paint bottle including an applicator brush

Materials Required:

Mild detergent and water

Clean rag

Green 3M Scotch-Brite pad, 00 steel wool or 220 grit sandpaper

Isopropyl alcohol

Step 1

Clean the surface. Clean surface with mild detergent and water to remove any dirt, oil, chalk, or other residue.



Step 2

Dull the surface. Scuff the surface using the green 3M Scotch-Brite pad, 00 steel wool or 220 grit sandpaper until surface is dull or deglossed.



Step 4

Mix the paint.

Shake touch-up paint bottle vigorously to make sure the contents are thoroughly combined.

Step 5

Apply the paint.

Apply the touch-up paint using even, steady brush strokes. For repair on a larger area, a foam brush technique may provide the best results.



Touch-up Paint Tips:

For best results, make sure temperatures are between 60° F and 85° F during applications, with night-time temperatures above 40° F.

Paint curing time ranges from 24–48 hours, depending upon conditions. Avoid applying touch-up paint during periods of high humidity or rain. Additional curing time may be required.

Step 3

Treat the surface. Wipe surface to be painted with isopropyl alcohol and allow the surface to dry thoroughly.



Step 6

Recoat as needed. If multiple coats are needed, recoat within 15 minutes or after 48 hours of applying the initial coat.
